



Camp Albemarle Counselor Job Description

Reports to: Head Counselor

Dates of Job: May 28 – August 4 2017

Purpose of Position:

- Tend to the individual needs of the campers in your cabin.
- Be a friend, role model, and supervisor to the campers in your cabin.
- Guide the kids in your cabin spiritually, by speaking with them as a small group, answering their questions, and caring for them individually.

Qualifications:

- Must be a professed Christian and follower of Jesus Christ and his teachings
- Must be at least 18 years of age, or turning 18 by September (Class of 2017)
- Must be able to stay at camp from open to close for the majority of camp sessions (except for daily time off)
- Preferred to be CPR/First Aid certified by the beginning of camp sessions (We provide CPR/First Aid training during staff week)

Specific Responsibilities:

- Attend and participate in staff week. (If not possible, please contact us)
- Check campers in and out with their parents as they are dropped off and picked up.
- Plan daily Bible studies with your brother/sister counselor.
- Plan a team building block with your brother/sister counselor at the beginning of the week.
- Plan nightly devotions with your co-counselor if you are a residential counselor for the week.
- Plan a skit with your campers and co-counselor at the end of the session.
- Attend, participate, and help facilitate all daily activities with the campers in your half cabin. (except for daily time off)
- Carry all emergency medical supplies (epi-pens, inhalers, etc.) for your campers, and ensure that your brother/sister counselor has them during your time off.
- Tend to all the needs of campers to the best of your ability, or contact appropriate staff (medical officer, spiritual development coordinator, head counselor, etc.) for situations beyond your training or comfort.
- Encourage all campers, but specifically those in your cabin and family group to participate, and have fun in all activities.
- Act as program staff during weeks in which it is needed.
- Act as program staff after day camp checks out if you are a day camp counselor for the week.
