



Camp Albemarle Environmental Education Director Job Description

Dates of Job: May 22 – August 4 2017

Purpose of Position:

- Create exciting, unique, and fun environmental programs for each session.
- Care for the small animals, garden and greenhouse and advise in the purchase of new equipment.

Qualifications:

- Must be a professed Christian and follower of Jesus Christ and his teachings
- Must be at least 19 years of age, or turning 19 by September (Class of 2015)
- Must be able to stay at camp from open to close for the majority of camp sessions (except for daily time off)
- Must be CPR/First Aid certified by the beginning of camp sessions (We provide CPR/First Aid training during staff week)
- Familiarity with gardening and small animal care as well as experience providing Educational Environmental, earth care activities.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Attend, participate, and lead in leadership training, program training, and staff week.
- Design one or more hour-long environmental education projects for each session.
- Direct counselors to ensure environmental education activities are run smoothly and campers have fun.
- Maintain environmental education equipment, and consult with the program director on the purchasing of new environmental education equipment.
- At any such time where there are no environmental education programs, act as program staff.
