

# Camp Albemarle

## Parent Information



- Choose session and register for camp. You must pay a deposit for the registration to process.
  - The 2014 Camp Albemarle T-shirt and the Email/ Photo service are included in the camp tuition this summer.
  - This service allows you to view photos of your camper each day and send them emails. Instructions for accessing the service will be available at registration.
  - You will be allowed to include one cabinmate (roommate) request—this request will be honored if it is reciprocated.
- Prior to June 1, complete payment for your camper. Invoices are emailed out monthly and payments can be made online with a credit card or by mailing a check to the camp office.
- Prior to June 1, fill out the health form online. This can be accessed in the same place where you registered your camper.
- When preparing for camp, remember to include:
  - Bible
  - Sleeping bag/Sheets and a pillow
  - Towels (at least two)
  - Toothbrush and other toiletries (it may be handy to have a shower caddy to bring these to and from the bathhouse)
  - Pajamas
  - Shorts, shirts, socks, underwear (they may also need at least one pair of pants and a light jacket)
  - Shoes (at least two pair)
  - Water Shoes
  - Bathing Suit (one piece recommended for females)
  - Sunscreen
  - Raincoat or poncho
  - Flashlight
  - Small Fan

It may also be nice to have pre-addressed stationary or postcards and a small clip on fan. Remember, no food or electronic devices are allowed in the cabins.

- Registration is at 3:00 on opening day (generally Sunday). At registration, you will review your camper's health form and/ or MAR form with the Camp Nurse, have the option of setting up an account at the camp store (cash, check, or visa for souvenirs), receive your camper's t-shirt and receive their cabin assignment.
- While your camper is at Camp Albemarle, they can receive letters addressed to them (include their cabin number) at 156 Albemarle Dr., Newport, NC 28570. Because packages can cause many problems (limited space to store them, some campers feeling left out, food/candy attracting critters), we will only accept packages that are no larger than 12"x15"x3/4".
- This year we will be holding a closing program at the Vesper Dell! We invite all friends and families to join us for songs, dancing, high points of the week, and closing worship for what will have been a spectacular week. This program will begin at 2pm, please do not arrive before 1:30pm and go straight to the Vesper Dell or Camp Store as campers will be finishing cleaning their cabins and playing games. After the program is finished you can head to your campers cabin and sign them out with their counselor and pick up your luggage (please do not try to do this before the program as it creates problems for the counselor's supervision of the campers and we would like to minimize traffic). After the program, there will also be a treat served out of the Pavilion, that week's slideshow playing in the Lodge, and the Camp Store will remain open.
- If you arrive home and discover something was left at camp, lost and found is kept for one week following your camper's session, then donated to a local charity. Contact Camp Albemarle as soon as possible to arrange to get the item back.
