



Camp Albemarle Spiritual Development Coordinator Job Description

Reports to: Assistant Director

Dates of Job: May 22 – August 4 2017

Purpose of Position:

- Create an informative, encouraging, and enriching spiritual environment for the campers and staff through vespers messages and one-on-one interactions.
- Provide answers to campers' faith questions, and point them back to scripture and their home church if applicable.

Qualifications:

- Must be a professed Christian and follower of Jesus Christ and his teachings
- Must be at least 20 years of age, or turning 20 by September (Class of 2015)
- Must be able to stay at camp from open to close for the majority of camp sessions (except for daily time off)
- Preferred to be CPR/First Aid certified by the beginning of camp sessions (We provide CPR/First Aid training during staff week)
- Preferred Christian Education or Seminary experience

Specific Responsibilities:

- Attend, participate, and lead in leadership training, program training, and staff week.
- During staff week, along with staff, create a four-day Bible study plan including options for different games relevant to the lesson, and questions for each age group.
- Coordinate a nightly vespers message 10-20 minutes long. This can be occasionally performed by another staff member on occasion.
- Attend Bible studies with as many family groups as possible, and participate as appropriate.
- Attend devotions with as many cabins as possible, and participate as appropriate.
- As possible, be available to speak individually with campers about faith topics.
- Occasionally perform the responsibilities of program staff as time allows.
