

Hello Preschool and Kindergarten Camp Families,

We are very excited that your child will be attending summer camp! Preschool and Kindergarten summer camps are run differently from the rising 1st-12th grade camps so make sure to thoroughly read the following information. Camp Times

Preschool and Kindergarten camps run from 9am to 1pm. There are no early drop off or late pick up options.

Snack and Lunch

Nature School/Camp Albemarle will provide a healthy nut free snack each day. **You need to provide a healthy nut free lunch each day for your child.** Wow Butter and Sunbutter are alternatives to send instead of peanut butter. Send one or two ice packs in your child's lunchbox to keep the food cold. Send an insulated water bottle every day.

Supplies Needed Each Day

Your child should come with a small backpack (they must be able to carry it on their own) with the following items. Every item needs to be labeled with your child's name!

- Bathing suit, water shoes and towel
- Change of clothes including underwear. Place extra clothes in a Ziploc bag.
- Nut free lunch and insulated water bottle
- Sunscreen and bugspray (spray kind recommended)
- Hat – not required but recommended

Children need to wear closed toe shoes. We recommend they wear fast drying clothing. Children participate in play with mud and water so your child may come home dirty.

Check In/Out Details

This information will be released one week prior to the start of your child's first day of camp.

Sound Exploration Day

Depending on the tides, we hope to take our campers into the sound to look for critters when the tide is low. Camp Albemarle has life jackets available, but we ask that you send your child with one if you already have one at home (No need to go purchase one!) **Your child will also need closed toe water shoes that fit snugly on the foot. Crocs and Natives are not allowed as we have lost these in the water!** You will be informed on the first day of camp when your child's water day will be.

Independent Bathroom Skills Required

Your child must be fully independent in the bathroom for him/her to attend camp. Children must be in underwear and may not come in pull-ups. Teachers will assist the children with their clothing if needed and will change a child if he/she has an accident. However, we do not have the staff or facilities to change children on a regular basis. If a child has multiple accidents in one day or has accidents two days in a row, we will notify a parent to pick up their child from camp.
